## Course Outline

A must for every workplace. This course increases meaningful conversations, improves employee wellbeing, and gives employees confidence to ask for support when needed.

- Substance use problems
  - Signs, symptoms and interventions.
- The MHFA Action Plan for substance use problems
  - Crisis first aid for severe effects of substance use
  - Crisis first aid for aggressive behaviour
